Pilotage is compulsory for all vessels of over 200 tons on entering and leaving the port, with the exception of pleasure craft.







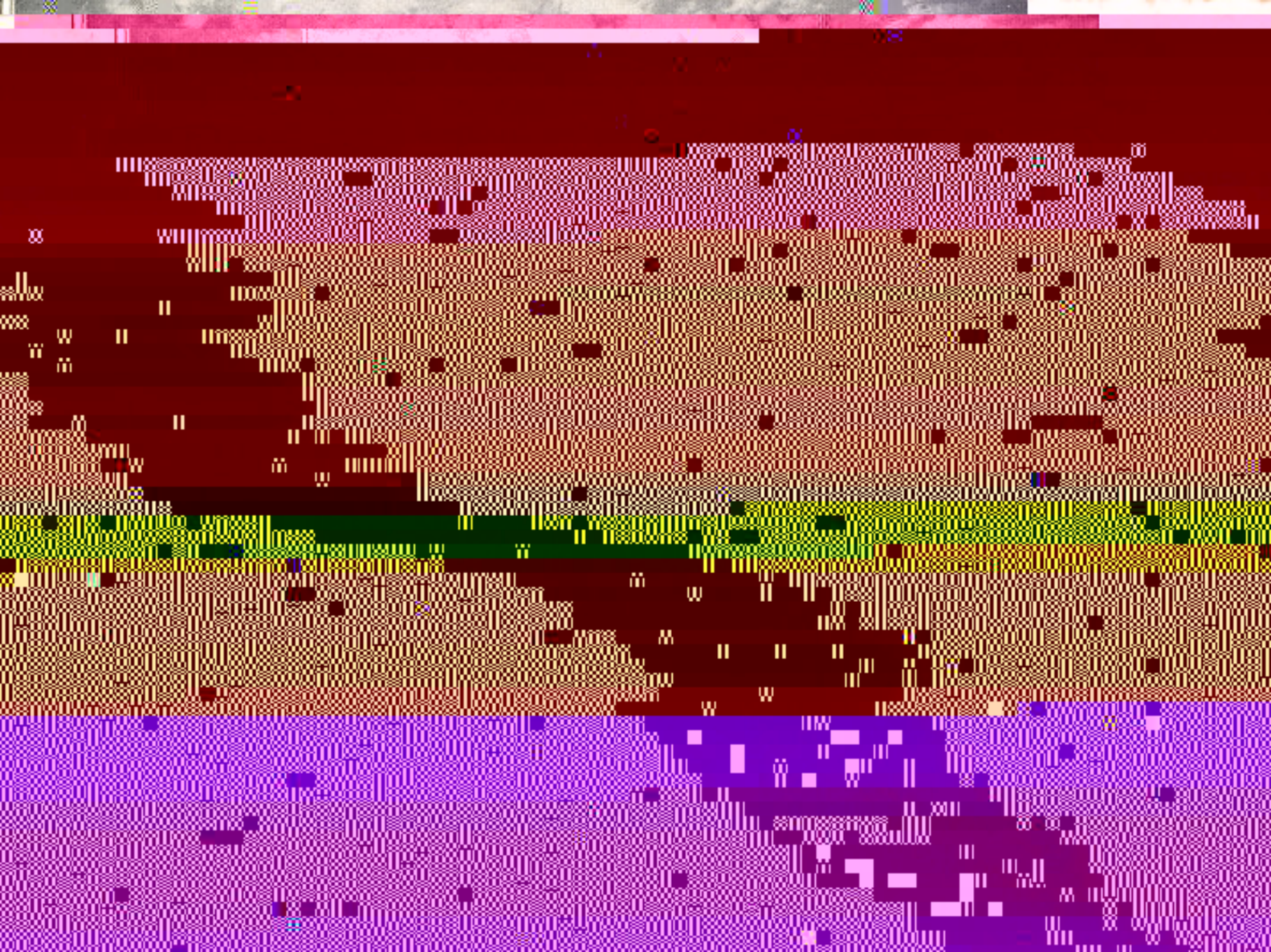
